Notification

S.O. 3984 WHEREAS by the notification of the Government of India in  
the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) No. S.O. 508, dated the  
27th January, 1979, under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal  
Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957),  
the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the  
lands in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that  
notification;

AND WHEREAS the competent authority in pursuance  
of section 8 of the said Act has made his report to the Central  
Government;

AND WHEREAS the Central Government, after considering  
the ~~para~~ report aforesaid, and after consulting the Government of  
Bihar, is satisfied that the lands measuring 253.00 acres (approx-  
imately) or 102.38 hectares (approximately) described in the  
Schedule appended hereto, should be acquired;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred  
by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the said Act, the Central  
Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 253.00 acres  
(approximately) or 102.38 hectares (approximately), described  
the said Schedule, are hereby acquired.


- A-B-C lines pass through plot number 3020 in village Dhorhi.
