NOTIFICATION

S.O. Whereas by the Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) No. S.O. 664 dated the 10th January 1983, issued under sub-section (i) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the lands in the locality specified in the schedule appended to that notification;

And whereas the Competent Authority, in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act, has made his report to the Central Government;

And whereas the Central Government, after considering the report aforesaid, and after consulting the Government of Bihar, is satisfied that the lands measuring 1350 acres (approximately) or 546.32 hectares (approximately), described in the Schedule appended hereto, should be acquired.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(1) of section 9 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 1350 acres (approximately) or 546.32 hectares (approximately), described in the said Schedule, are hereby acquired.

The plans or the area covered by this notification may be inspected in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Hazribagh (Bihar) or in the Office of the Coal Controller, 1, Council House Street, Calcutta or in the Office of the Central Coalfields Ltd., (Revenue Section) Darbhanga House, Ranchi (Bihar).

D-E : line passes along the part common boundary of villages Durukasmar & Basantpur (which also forms part common boundary with Kedla North Colliery) and meets at point 'E'.

E-F : line passes through plot numbers 476, 477, 535, 534, 636, 533, 545, 546, 548, 549, 550, 552, 559, 558, 557, 634, 635, 634 & 674 (Nalla) in village Durukasmar (which forms common boundary of West Bokaro Colliery) and meets at point 'F'.
